Someone said, "The world is spinning out of control. How can I respond?" Someone else answered. "Remain steadfast in your daily spiritual life."

In your spiritual life through prayer combined with sacrifice (self-denial,) even small acts, are powerful. **Fr. Basil Cole, OP** (in one of our early interviews) said that even a small number of dedicated people can change the course of history or mitigate punishment. **LET US BE AMONG THE FEW**. Fr. Cole is available on YouTube.

May 13, 1913, marked the first Marian apparition at Fatima. Sister Lucia, one of the three children of Fatima, gave a rare interview with the following message. It represents great hope for humanity.

"There is no problem, I tell you, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot solve by the prayer of the Rosary."

Sr. Lucia died February 16, 2005 at the age of 97. Her cause is advancing. Pope Benedict XVI on the third anniversary of her death declared her "Worthy Servant." Pope Francis proclaimed her "Venerable" on June 22, 2023

It was to Our Lady of Fatima that Pope John Paul II attributed his life being spared, May 13, 1981 from assassination attempt. One year later, Pope John Paul went on pilgrimage to Fatima in thanksgiving. He met with Sister Lucia on three occasions, the latest in 2000.

Reflection: It is easy to see Mary's role, as Our Mother.



The Tradition of the May Altar

During the Month of Mary, Blessed Mother sends abundant graces upon us. We do have to ask for them.

In a special place in your home, a May altar with a statue of Mary (or even a picture of Mary can be set-up). Flowers and a basket for special intentions may be added. It is a place to pray the Rosary. Invite others to join you and to add their intentions.

June - the Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus



Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: the "Devotion of Devotions."

Pius XI called devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus the "devotion of devotions," and "the very summary of our religion." Almost eighty years later, Pope Benedict XVI said that this devotion "has an irreplaceable importance" for us and is "indispensable." It seems that now, more than ever, we need the graces that flow from the Heart of Jesus.

St. Paul wrote that "where sin increased, grace overflowed all the more" (Romans. 5:20). We would have to be blind or naïve to not see how much sin has increased in our world. But what about grace? Will it overflow "all the more?" Only if we turn to the Sacred Heart, "the greatest human expression of divine love" (Pope Francis).

Before he became pope, Benedict XVI wrote a commentary on the message of Fatima. There he said: "since God himself took a human heart and has thus steered human freedom towards what is good, the freedom to choose evil no longer has the last word."

When we live in union with the Heart of Jesus, we open ourselves up to grace, to the only power capable of changing the world by overcoming sin. We open ourselves up to the power of Jesus' death and resurrection. Referring to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Heart that was most like the Sacred Heart, Pope Benedict said: "The Heart open to God, purified by contemplation of God, is stronger than guns and weapons of every kind."

Let us pray with faith:

Jesus and Mary, make my heart like Your Hearts.
May the grace and love that are in Your Hearts fill
my heart to overflowing and touch the hearts of others,
overcoming sin in myself and in others.
