National Eucharistic Pilgrimage

"Renewal of America"

"As we celebrate the 250th anniversary of our nation, a Eucharistic Pilgrimage will take place beginning on Memorial Day weekend. The Eucharistic Procession will begin at the site of the first Mass on which was to be the United States, in 1565, at St. Augustine, Florida.

The procession will travel through most of the original 13 colonies ending in Philadelphia on the Fourth of July weekend. It is in honor of the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. Thousands are expected to participate by attending Masses, Adoration, prayer moments along the sacred journey to Philadelphia.

According to Bishop Andrew Cozzens, Chairman of National Eucharistic Congress, "This pilgrimage is a powerful reminder that the deepest foundation of our country is our dependence on God by carrying the Eucharist across our nation in prayer. We are asking the Lord to renew the Church and to bless our country so that we may truly be one nation under God."

"**The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage** is one of the most visible expressions of that renewal. As Catholics carry Jesus in the Eucharist (Monstrance) through streets and communities, it becomes both a public witness of faith and a personal invitation for people everywhere to encounter Him," stated Jason Shanks, President of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage.

We, too, are invited to participate by pledging Holy Hours. It is hoped that 250,000 Holy Hours will be pledged for the renewal of America.

The Tradition of the May Altar

During the month of Mary, Blessed Mother sends abundant graces upon us. We do have to ask for them. In a special place in your home, a May altar with a statue of Mary or even a picture of Mary can be set-up. Flowers and a basket for your intentions may be added. It is a place to pray the Rosary. 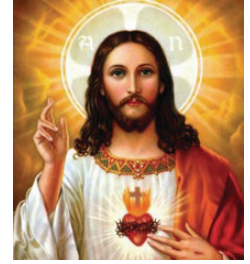

Directions to install the Radio Family Rosary App:

For iPhone or iPad:

- Open Safari browser on your iPhone or iPad.
- Visit app.radiofamilyrosary.com.
- Tap the "Share" icon at the bottom of the Safari screen (square with an up arrow).
- Select "Add to Home Screen" from the share options.
- Confirm the installation by tapping the "Add" button.

For Android devices

(using Chrome browser):

- From Chrome, open app.radiofamilyrosary.com.
- Click on the setting (three dots in upper right hand corner).
- Scroll down and select "Add to Home screen."
- Confirm by tapping Add. The RFR will appear on your home screen.
